Tamás megjegyzései: electro, electronic music, electronica Disco/Electro: Two genres from different eras, both with roots in seventies funk. [[Disco]] took its name from the 'discotheque', the 70s clubs devoted entirely to dance music, where the groove was the most integral part of the music. [[Electro]] took elements of funk and added a dash if hip hop culture, producing a synthesiser-based sound that is still referenced by artists today. [[Electronica]] is a genre that covers a wide range of electronic music that, while using many of the same techniques used in the creation if dance music, is more often produced with home-listening in mind. Electronica experienced a massive growth in popularity when the availability of cheap home computers and software created a cottage industry of individuals creating recordings of a professional standard. [[Electronica/Dance is based around the use of synthesized and sampled sounds, with tempos ranging from beatless to 300 bpm.
