# ACADEMY AWARDS® THROUGH THE YEARS

## HOLLYWOOD


### ★ ACADEMY AWARDS® THROUGH THE YEARS

- 1929 - First Academy Awards® ceremony
- 1930 - Only seven categories awarded at second annual ceremony
- 1934 - Shirley Temple is youngest person to receive an Oscar® at age six
- 1939 - Hattie McDaniel is first black actor to win an Oscar® for "Gene with the Winds"
- 1942 - Greer Garson gives longest speech ever at five minutes, 30 seconds
- 1943 - 45-second time limit for speeches instituted
- 1953 - First televised Academy Awards® ceremony
- 1966 - The ceremony is telecast in color for the first time
- 1968 - Alfred Hitchcock gives one of the shortest speeches ever: "THANKS!"
- 1970 - Midnight Cowboy is the only X-Rated movie to ever win an Oscar®
- 1972 - Charlie Chaplin receives longest standing ovation in Academy Awards® history, at five minutes
- 1981 - Telecast is postponed one day because of the attempted assassination of Ronald Reagan
- 1998 - At age 87 Gloria Stuart is oldest person to be nominated for an Oscar®, for "Titanic"
- TV ratings for Academy Awards® are highest ever recorded, at 55M
- 2002 - Longest televised Academy Awards® ceremony ever, at 4.5 hours
- 2008 - TV ratings for Academy Awards® are lowest ever recorded, at 31.8M
- 2010 - Kathryn Bigelow is first female to win an Oscar® for directing

### ★ OSCAR® WINNERS BY THE NUMBERS

- 28 - Walt Disney's record for most Oscars received by an individual
- 14 - Meryl Streep's record for most acting nominations
- 11 - The record for most wins for a movie. "Titanic", "Ben-Hur" and "Lord of the Rings: The Return of the King" are tied
- 11 - The record for most snubs for a movie. "The Turning Point" and "The Color Purple" both had 11 nominations and zero wins
- 8 - Peter O'Toole's record for most snubs for an actor. He has eight nominations and no wins
- 6 - The number of actors who have won both best actor and best supporting actor. (Jack Lemmon, Robert DeNiro, Jack Nicholson, Gene Hackman, Kevin Spacey, Denzel Washington)
- 2 - The number of actors who have won an Oscar for playing Don Corleone (Marlon Brando for "Godfather" and Robert DeNiro for "Godfather II")
- 1 - The number of actors to be nominated for Best Actor and Best Supporting Actor for the same role (Barry Fitzgerald as Father Fitzgibbon in "Going My Way")
